Subject: Effective flood mitigation measures.

> Government Order No. 36 -DMRRR of 2017 Dated: 01.06.217

Sanction is hereby accorded to constitution of the following committee to ensure effective flood mitigation, in Kashmir Division:

i.	Divisional Commissioner Kashmir	Chairman
ii.	Inspector General of Police, Kashmir	Member
iii.	Deputy Commissioner Srinagar	Member
iv.	Chief Engineer I&FC Kashmir	Member Secretary

- Divisional Commissioner Kashmir may co-opt any other officer, as may be deemed necessary.
- In the event of any impending flood, the resources available with any department e.g. SMC, MED, R&B, MED, SDRF, Police, Civil Defence etc., (including manpower and machinery) may be pooled together, commandeered and redeployed, for flood duty, on the instructions of the Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir.
- Chief Engineer, Irrigation and Flood Control (I&FC) Department shall ensure that a dedicated Central Flood Control Room is set up at Srinagar, equipped with landlines, broadband, fax and wireless communication network. Duty roster of staff be notified for manning the Flood Control Room on 24x7 basis.
- Areas vulnerable to floods shall be identified and mapped by the 5. Irrigation & Flood Control Deptt. The vulnerable areas shall be divided into Zones. Each Zone headed by a Zonal Magistrate, to be nominated by the concerned Deputy Commissioner.
- The constitution of the Zonal Committees shall comprise of:

(i)	Zonal Magistrate.	Chairman
(ii)	Engineer from I&FC.	Member Secy
(iii)	Engineer from R&B.	Member
(iv)	Municipal Ward Officer(assisted by municipal staff).	Member
(v)	I/c Police Station.	Member
(vi)	Numberdar/Chowkidar/Sarpanch/ Panch (whichever	Members
	is applicable)	

Member (vii) I/c SDRF component.

(viii) Civil Defence, Home Guards, Community Members Volunteers/Local NGO.

- 7. Adequate boats shall be requisitioned by the concerned Deputy Commissioner, and pre-positioned at Police Stations. These boats shall be utilised on the demand of the Zonal Magistrates. The Zonal teams shall be responsible for the rescue operations, within their area.
- 8. Labours and pick-up vans/tippers etc. shall be pooled from various departments, equipped with tools and filled-up sand-bags and kept attached with each team, for immediate response.
- 9. Zonal Magistrate shall ensure that safety measures are taken and if required, the vulnerable population shall be shifted to safer locations/relief camps.
- 10. Concerned Deputy Commissioner shall identify rescue/relief shelters and pre-position relief material and medical facilities at these Centres.
- 11. Each Zonal team shall conduct mock drills, to test their preparedness.
